2. What we talked about:
 - a. A **New Health Support Service** that will help people to find out if they have autism is being planned. It will help other Doctors so people do not have to wait too long to find out if they have autism.
 - b. The **AutisMe App** is still being tried out by people with autism and there will be a meeting in January 2016 to see how good it is. So far people think it is good.
 - c. The **Monday Club is making a film** about 'a day in the life of a person with autism'. It will film shopping, using a bus and making a phone call. It will be finished in February 2016. A volunteer to help with film editing is wanted so please contact Naomi if you are interested.
 - d. **The Autism Network** has started on the internet and this is for people working with autism to use for help and support in their work.
 - e. The **National Autistic Society Shop** at Blaby Road, South Wigston – have a '**Drop In**' the first Monday of every month – the next 'Drop-In' will be Monday 4th January 2016.
