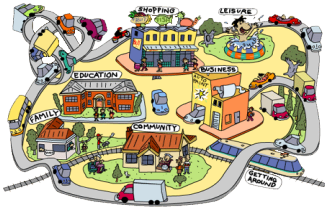
I have a paid job at

- We support people to do what they want to do and help them to try new things.

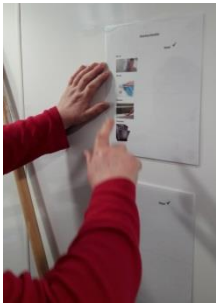


- We are open Monday to Friday unless there is a bank holiday or staff training

I have my jobs to do printed out and put on the wall so I can see what I have to do every day



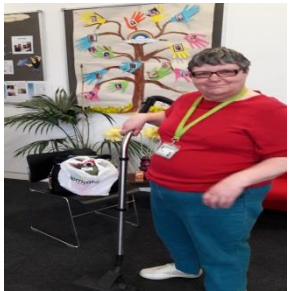
I have to clean and polish all the mirrors in the toilets

It is a charity, which needs money from the general public



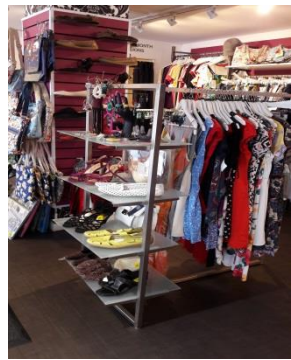
People can fund raise, make donations, or volunteer to help, like Lorna does
