(LeDeR) Programme

- NHS England have said we should look at all deaths of people with learning disabilities in England
- The new work is called the Learning Disabilities Death Review Programme. It is also called LeDeR Programme

Learning Disability Mortality Review



- Every area will be supported to check up on all deaths of people with learning disabilities
- Information will be collected about all deaths
- Some deaths will be looked at in more detail

Learning Disability Mortality Review



- The reviews will look at what has worked well and what has not worked well
- The information will be used to make health and social care services for people with learning disabilities better

Learning Disability Mortality Review



- Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland are working together to reviews the deaths of people with a learning disability
- Local steering group

Constipation



- 1 in 3 people with a learning disability are constipated
- Constipation can be very serious
- 2 people died in Suffolk
