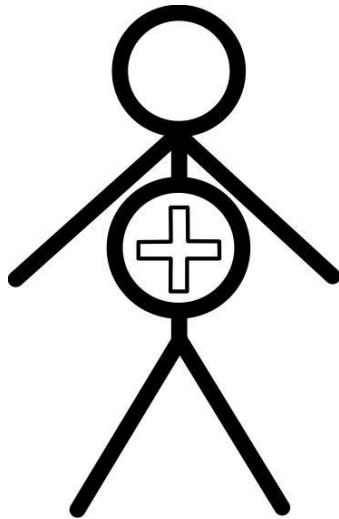
- Move people out of hospital who should not be there
- Have the right services to support you where you live
- Stop you going into hospital unless you really need to

The 9 Principles



- I have an interesting life that I enjoy
- My Care and Support is well planned
- I have choice and control about my care and support

The 9 Principles



- I live in the community with the support I need
- I have a choice about where I live and who I live with
- I get good care from health services

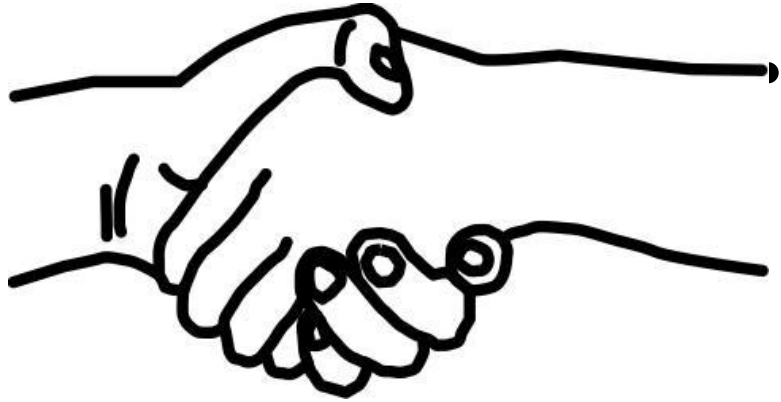
The 9 Principles



- I get help from experts in the community when I need it
- I get help to stay out of trouble with the Police if I need it
- If I have to go into a hospital because my health needs cannot be met in the community, I is high quality and I don't stay there longer than I need to



What we are doing in Leicestershire



Working with Leicester City Council, Rutland County Council and Health



- More Outreach support
- Less beds in the Agnes Unit
- Step through project

What we are doing in Leicestershire



- Care and Treatment reviews – checking that people are not in hospital longer than they need to be
- We need to make sure we have people who can support us to do the Care and Treatment reviews

What we are doing in Leicestershire



- Make sure we know if someone might need to go to hospital – Admission Avoidance register
- Checking every week who is in hospital and plans for them to leave

What we are doing in Leicestershire



- Working with other services who might work with people with learning disabilities
- Making there are houses for people to live in

Joint Health and Social Care Self Assessment – LD SAF

- Local areas need to write an action plan in February
- New LD SAF will be launched in from April 2016
