## What is supported housing?

- Supported housing is a range of houses for vulnerable people.





## What is happening?

- The Government is looking at ways to make benefits work better for everybody. Some changes have been made already.





These changes have not yet been made to people living in supported housing





## The future

- The government are taking a fresh look at supported housing





## What do they want to know?

- They want to find out why supported housing costs so much money







## What do they want to do?

- They want to make sure that supported housing works well for everyone





## What happens next?

- For the time being nothing will change





## Future plans

- The Government will do some research





## Future plans

- The research will be done by Spring 2016





## What happens next?

- The Government will decide what they want to do this is called a policy





## The policy

- The policy will let people know what is going to happen to supported housing in the future





## What will change?

- The Government have said that they want to find the best way to help people living in supported housing.
