- your reports

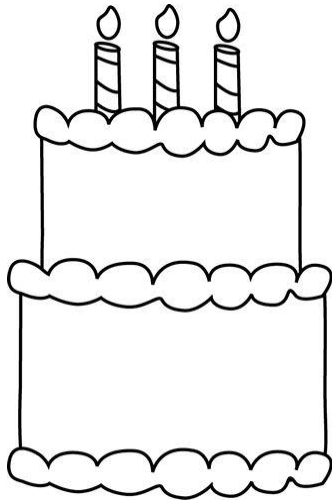
with professionals like:

This is called sharing information and helps us to help you.



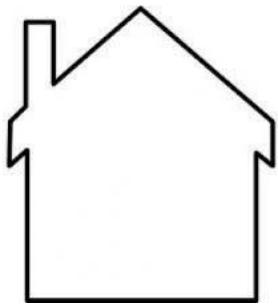

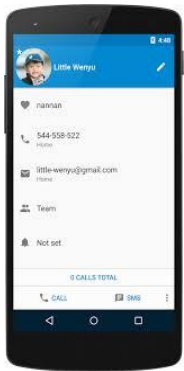
