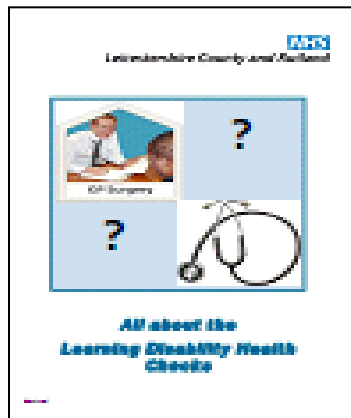


Primary Care Liaison Nursing Team

- 74% of those people had a health check

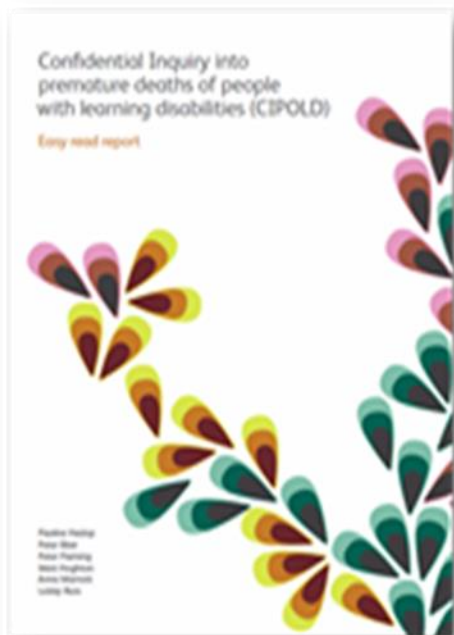
The things we are working on this year

- We told them all about the LeDeR review so that they know that someone will want to talk to them if they were involved in a persons care before they died
