WHAT IS A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP?



- ✓ **On the job training programme run by a local college**
- ✓ **Develops skills needed for work**
- ✓ **Opportunity to work on Maths, English & Employability skills**
- ✓ **Unpaid**
- ✓ **Usually lasts an academic year**

WHO IS A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP FOR?



Young people aged 16-24 who:

- ✓ Have an EHC Plan
- ✓ Want to work
- ✓ Need extra support to move into employment

HOW DOES A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP HELP?

- ✓ Support to develop skills valued by employers,
- ✓ Develops confidence and builds self-esteem,
- ✓ Demonstrates value in the workplace. (Shows how good you are!)
- ✓ Gives the Intern a real idea about how to manage in the workplace.
- ✓ Gives them a chance to try different jobs
